24H TRIO - BUS - TRAM - COACH1

Valid for 1 to 3 passengers for 24 hours following first validation, for an unlimited number of journeys in the Eurometropolis of Strasbourg.

3 DAY PASS - BUS - TRAM - COACH1

Valid for a single passenger for 3 calendar days from the first day of validation for an unlimited number of journeys in the Eurometropolis of Strasbourg.

COMBINED SINGLE TICKET **BUS - TRAM - COACH**

Valid for a single journey or a journey with transfers after the first validation, on bus, tram and coach lines. Sold only on the CTS mobile app.

DOUZEPASS

Single ticket in sets of 12 for visually impaired passengers or disabled war veterans, only on Badgéo card.

PROCEDURE

Secure evidence of your family quotient

- Recipients of CAF benefits: the family quotient is stated on the payment certificate (available on caf.fr, My account).
- Non-recipients of CAF benefits and non-scholarship students can secure evidence of their family quotient:
 - on the website demarches.strasbourg.eu, section Health/Social,
 - from their local town hall or CCAS (Centre Communal d'Action Sociale) or the medical-social centre of their neighbourhood by presenting their latest tax notice, identification and their livret de famille [family record book].
 - for non-residents in the Eurometropolis of Strasbourg: from the CCAS of Strasbourg - more information on our website.

If your family quotient is below or equal to €795 or if you are a scholarship student, go to:

OR

- > The CTS sales office, along with:
 - your identity document (and those of your dependents if necessary)
 - your Badgéo card (and those of your dependents if necessary)
 - CAF beneficiary: your certificate of payment dated from less than 3 months (NB: only printed versions are accepted)
 - non-beneficiary of CAF: your family quotient certificate dated from less than 3 months (NB: present the email accompanying the certificate if obtained from the website of the Eurometropolis of Strasbourg)
 - scholarship students: your scholarship notification for the current year issued by the CROUS, the ministry for Agriculture or the Grand Est Region (for healthcare and social studies students)

50 % COVERAGE BY YOUR EMPLOYER

Your employer can pay for at least half the cost of your travel card.

ACCESS TO TER TRAINS



CTS app

With the CTS app, buy, manage and validate your tickets with your smartphone.

Top up your Badgéo card directly with your smartphone (NFC compatible).

Vending machines

All tickets (except Park & Ride tickets) and **travel cards** can be purchased from the vending machines at tram stations, on lines G and H, and some bus stops. Payment by bank card (no minimum) or cash (coins only, maximum of 20 coins).

From the 25th of the current month, you can buy your travel card for the next two months.



CTS sales outlets

Almost all transport tickets (tickets and travel cards) are available from CTS sales outlets (Vélhop shop, tobacconists and newspaper shops, bakeries, etc.).

8 Travelling lawfully

Card lost or stolen?

You can ask for a **duplicate Badgéo solo card** with all the tickets contained in it at the time of the report. The request may be made online on our website, section: Online store or CTS office.

You will need the following:

- an identification document
- a recent identification photograph
- €8 (price of duplicate)

The Badgéo multi card cannot be duplicated.

Refund

In special cases, CTS could **replace** or **refund** your tickets, **mainly in the form of purchase vouchers**. To do so, please contact us **by post** or **using the refund form** on our website, section: Contact.

Cancellation

Do you want to cancel a travel card? Please send your request by post or complete the cancellation request form available on our website, section: Contact.

To be effective the following month, the request must be made **before the 20th** of the month. After that date, the next month will be charged.

Ombudsman

Any customer dispute concerning the performance of a travel card agreement may be submitted to the consumer dispute ombudsman. To make an appeal, the customer must first demonstrate that they have attempted to settle the dispute with the Customer Relations and Commercial Development Department (DRCDC) of CTS through a written complaint. However, the parties to the agreement remain free to accept or refuse the use of the services of the ombudsman.

The solution proposed by the ombudsman is not binding on the parties to the agreement.



Inside the vehicle in buses.

For **trams** and **bus lines G and H**, the ticket is to be validated on the validator installed **on the platform**, **before you board the vehicle**. The validator displays a sign and emits a sound to confirm validation.

DID YOU KNOW?

If you hold your contactless ticket on the validator once again, the available ticket balance is displayed on the validator screen.

Examples of offences & penalties

Any offender on board CTS trams and buses is liable for a penalty in an amount that varies according to the offence. Example:

No ticket € 60*

Immediate payment

Smoking € 70*

Immediate payment

Refusal to comply €. 150*

Immediate payment

*€40 processing surcharge for deferred payment.

Immediate payment avoids the €40 processing charge.

Penalties may be paid immediately in cash, by bank card or cheque.

5 Passengers' guide

Pets

Only small dogs kept in a closed basket or guide dogs for the blind or assistance dogs are allowed. In vehicles where that is allowed, other dogs are allowed muzzled and kept on a leash (except dangerous dogs). Wheelchair spaces

Wheelchairs have priority access to reserved spaces.
Walkers and rollators are also allowed on buses and trams.



Smoking and vaping

As in all public places, **smoking is not allowed on buses and trams.** The use of electronic cigarettes is also prohibited.

To stop smoking, you can get help by calling 39 89 (€0.15/min, Tabac Info Service).

(decree no. 2006-1386 of 15 November 2006 setting the conditions for the application of the smoking ban in places for collective use).

Noise

The use of any audio device or mobile phone is **permitted only with headphones, providing the volume does not disturb other passengers.**



Large objects and hazardous materials

The transport of bulky objects and hazardous materials is prohibited on buses and trams.

Reserved seats

All passengers are asked to give up their seats to holders of cards stating "need of accompaniment" or "need of accompaniment-blindness", the elderly, pregnant women and passengers accompanied by children under 4 years of age.



Pushchairs

Pushchairs are to be parked in the wheelchair space if it is available.

The driver may refuse access by a pushchair if it causes inconvenience to other passengers or if there is a risk of accident.



On buses

- Unfolded e-scooters/push scooters and bicycles (folded or unfolded) are prohibited.
- Folded e-scooters/push scooters are allowed.

On trams

- Unfolded e-scooters/push scooters and bicycles are prohibited from Monday to Saturday from 7 am to 9 am and 5 pm to 7 pm.
 Depending on crowding, they are allowed outside these times, as well as on Sundays and public holidays.
- In case of a breakdown preventing the use of a bicycle, cyclists may board carriages regardless of the time and day, depending on crowding.
- Access on board is limited to no more than 2 bicycles or e-scooters/ push scooters per carriage (except on Sundays and public holidays, subject to space availability) and is only permitted using the rearmost door of the carriage.
- Folded bicycles and e-scooters/push scooters are permitted at all times, providing they are no larger than a suitcase.
- During the journey, owners must take care of their bicycle or e-scooter/push scooter and ensure stability and safety. Owners shall be fully liable within the limits of the law for any harm or damage caused to other passengers, CTS property, or themselves.

On buses and trams

- Segways, tricycles, cargo bikes, bicycles with trailers, mini motorcycles, and electric motorcycles are all prohibited.
- Cycling, scooter riding, skateboarding, and roller skating are all prohibited.
